Berry-Althoff is the biodynamic project of Imogen Berry and Robin Althoff, farming 10 ha of limestone vineyards in Aubais. Their minimalist, precise approach relies on hand-harvested grapes, native yeast fermentations, minimal sulfur, producing vibrant wines that capture the character of the Mediterranean.

74% Grenache & 26% Cinsault on estate vines located in Aubais (Gard). Organically and biodynamically farmed. Vines planted in 1983. Harvested by hand. Made in the méthode ancestrale process. The wines are bottled during fermentation at 28 g/L of residual sugar. Fermentation goes on in the bottle which will dissolve natural bubbles in this sparkling wine. After 9 months ageing on lees, the wines are riddled and disgorged at the estate. Fermentation with indigenous yeasts. Total SO2 15mg/l.
