Field blend of many different grape varieties including Grüner Veltliner, Scheurebe, Weissburgunder, Neuburger, Welschriesling, Muskat-Ottonel, Gewürztraminer and many more. Handpicked, 4 days of maceration, then pressed and naturally fermented in old barrels, aging about 6 months on the lees. The vineyard where the grapes come from is officially named "Fürstliches Prädium" but people in Gols have been calling it "Korea" since the 1950s. When we rented the vineyard in 2016 we decided to use this nickname for the wine made from there.
