About the Winery/Winemaker

Entre Pedras" translates to "between the stones," which is exactly where these indigenous vines live. Brilliant green shoots emerge through stacked volcanic rock, reaching for the sun while sheltering from fierce Atlantic winds behind an intricate maze of black basalt walls known as currais. If stretched end to end, these remarkable walls would circle the Earth five times.

Their modest roadside garage winery overlooks dramatic ocean cliffs, but the real magic develops where their most distinctive wines are aged in an ancient under vineyard cave lovingly restored in 2017 after his grandfather's passing. Today, Ricardo and André are building their holdings with four hectares of old-vine Arinto dos Açores, while simultaneously strengthening their partnerships with more than fifteen local, small plot, old-vines growers to craft their colorful collection of volcanic wines bursting with energy, nerve, personality, and that unmistakable island charm that leave you glowing - like them.
