About the Winery/Winemaker

Vinos Pijoan was born from the hand of Pau Pijoan, a Mexican of Catalan origin, a veterinary researcher by profession. Without claiming to be an oenologist, his long career as a scientist laid the foundation for a disciplined and methodical study of winemaking. Today Vinos Pijoan is an estate run by Pau's daughter, Silvana. She is a classical dancer turned sommelier turned professionally trained winemaker. Silvana is dedicated to low-intervention winemaking, organic farming, and honoring the history of the land and the grapes of her ancestors. At Vinos Pijoan, the philosophy is to create honest wines that embody the history of Baja's terroir as a region, reflecting its aridity, morning fog, wind, and afternoon heat, followed by cool, fresh nights.
