Ink

A dark, deep ruby color with violet reflections as per the "Ink" namesake. Juicy and fruit-forward with medium body and vibrant acidity. It has soft, moderate tannins and a spicy, elegant finish.

Pump overs for about 10 days to achieve a balanced extraction. After fermentation, the wine is transferred to large, neutral acacia wood casks for about two months to complete malolactic fermentation. It is then moved to neutral 500 and 1000-liter casks for another 8–10 months of aging.
