Infusion Orange Wine

Berry-Althoff is the biodynamic project of Imogen Berry and Robin Althoff, farming 10 hectares of limestone vineyards in Aubais while also sourcing certified organic fruit from trusted growers across southern France. Their minimalist, precise approach relies on hand-harvested grapes, native yeast fermentations, and little to no added sulfur, producing vibrant wines that capture the character of the Mediterranean.

50% Viognier and 50% Chardonnay on limestone from the Hauterivian. : Estate vines located in the Liverna in Aubais (Gard). Organically and biodynamically farmed. Yield 25hl/ha. Vines planted in the 90s. Harvested by hand. Aged 16 months in clay amphora and stainless steel tank. Spicy notes of turmeric and pepper, light tannic structure, and a quite crispy finish. To drink by its own to discover orange wine or to pair with an oily fish (herring, trout...)
